



## KEY STAGE 2 RESULTS 2019

**53% of children achieved the expected standard or higher in reading, writing and maths compared with 64% nationally**

0% of children achieved a high standard in reading, writing and maths.

**61% of children achieved the expected standard in reading compared with 73% nationally.**

14% of children achieved a high standard in reading.

**80% of children achieved the expected standard in writing compared with 78.5% nationally.**

5% of children achieved greater depth in writing.

**63% of children achieved the expected standard or higher in maths compared with 78.7% nationally.**

8% of children achieved a high standard in maths

**68% of children achieved the expected standard in grammar, punctuation and spelling compared to 78% nationally.**

20% of children achieved a high standard in grammar, punctuation and grammar.

### Progress scores (KS1 to KS2):

-2.3 for maths

-0.4 for reading

-0.3 for writing

### Average scaled scores:

Maths – 101 (compared to 105 nationally)

Reading – 102 (compared to 104.4 nationally)

Grammar, punctuation and spelling – 103 (compared to 106.3 nationally)
